HALF-KLAM and Multihull Overnight XI Saturday, June 12 and Sunday, June 13, 2010

*Race uses combined course corrected times.

*Will award Half-Klam Perpetual Cup/s.

TWENTY-SIX YEARS IN THE OFFERING!

This race is one of the longest fresh water lake races offered in the Northwest. **Race is eight to sixteen hours**, weather and wind dependent, offering a long day of racing nearly 40 miles. Two islands and other natural landmarks make up the mark roundings, keeping the race unique, as opposed to normal buoy racing. Long beats and a run that can last 3-5 hours provide an experience unmatched for inland sailing. Klamath Lake offers a wide variety of wind and lake conditions ranging from light and calm to upward of 20 knots and rough, so come prepared for both.

*NOTE: Race should finish before dark, but no guarantees.

TRANS-KLAM Multihull Enduro Saturday, June 26

Distance approx. 40 mi.

*Multihull Enduro is open to all multi-hull boats. Race covers same water as TRANS-KLAM.

*Race handicapped under Portsmouth prescriptions

*Uses corrected time

*Award Multihull Enduro Perpetual Cup

*This regatta **will be governed** by the Racing Rules of Sailing, with US Sailing Prescriptions, except as may be altered by class rules or as directed by the Sailing Instructions. ***Handicapping** will be done with reference to P.H.R.F. Northwest and Portsmouth systems.

*Five boats or more in a class may be scored as a fleet.

***Five races** are scheduled, however as few as three races may be used to score this regatta. There'll be no throw-outs.

***Registration** 3:00- 6:00pm, July 2
7:30- 8:45am, July 3

***Skippers' Meeting** 9:00am Saturday then "**On-Call Racing**"

*"**On-Call Racing**" 9:00am Sunday

***Sailing Instructions and course map** available July 2

***Trophies** 1st place (3 boats); 1st/2nd place (4 boats); 1st/2nd/3rd place (5+ boats) per class.

INSURANCE: Racers are expected to carry liability insurance to cover injury to person/s or damage to other boats while participating in the Half Klam, Trans Klam, and Firecracker Regatta. All racers should understand that racing can be dangerous or even fatal. Neither Klamath Yacht Club nor their agents will accept any liability for damage or injury caused before/during/after racing. Life jackets are required at all times while on the water, except by express permission of the skipper of each boat.



WHERE TO SPEND THE NIGHT? Free tent camping is available on-site. Club bathrooms/showers are available as well. KOA is in town. RV/5th wheel? Some on-site parking is available; ask us for suggestions. Of course there are motels & hotels around town. If possible, please leave dogs at home (but sometimes they just need to come along so bring your leash, pooper scooper and baggies).
